Gerrards Cross Book Fair in South Buckinghamshire is one of the largest and longest running independent book fairs in the country. The fair, now under the management of Richard Frost, is held 5 times a year in the large hall attached to The Memorial Centre, a few minutes walk from Gerrards Cross town centre.

With room for up to 25 stands, there is always a good mix of dealers specialising in all sorts of books, usually there are also some postcards and ephemera.

Some of the dealers will buy books brought to the fair. Advice can be given about book values. There is also a book binder present who can give advice about repairing and restoring books.
